Day 15 — Rejoice in Hope

Scripture: Romans 12:1:

"Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer."

Scripture: Psalm 126:5

Day 21 — Joy That Endures

Scripture: John 16:22

"Your hearts will rejoice, and no one will take your joy from you."

Reflection: The joy of Christ endures beyond emotions and circumstances. It is a quiet, radiant flame that no darkness can extinguish. Carry this joy into the days ahead.

Prayer: Creator God, fill me with lasting joy — the joy that flows from Your love and presence within me. Amen.
