Day 22 — Love Incarnate

Scripture: John 1:14

“And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us.” —

Reflection: God’s love is not abstract — it is personal and embodied. The Incarnation reveals a God who chooses to be with us, to share our joys and pains. Love takes form and stays.

Prayer: Creator God, teach me to recognize Your presence in the ordinary; let me welcome You as love that dwells among us. Amen.

Day 23 — Love that Forgives

Scripture: Ephesians 4:32

“Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another.”

Reflection: Love bears with faults and mends what is broken. Forgiveness reveals the generous heart of God and frees us to love more fully. This week, consider a relationship that needs a step toward reconciliation.

Prayer: Creator God, soften my heart to forgive and to be forgiven; heal what is wounded and bind us together in Your love. Amen.

Scripture: John 3:16

Prayer: Creator God, shape my hands to give like You — with humility and joy, that others may know Your loving presence. Amen.
